1. Information on how to enter and the prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The promoter is James Hardie Australia Pty Ltd (ABN 12 084 635 558) of 10 Colquhoun Street, Rosehill NSW 2142, telephone: 131 103 ("Promoter").
3. Entry is open to NSW residents aged 18 years or over who have a trade account at either Ison & Co, Nowra or Ison & Co South Nowra (collectively "Ison&Co" and each a "Participating Store"). Entrants must be trading in accordance with Ison&Co's trading terms throughout the Promotional Period and must not have overdue monies owing as at the 31/07/2019 in order to be eligible to claim any prize.
4. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, a Participating Store and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
5. The promotion commences on 01/05/19 and ends for purchases at close of business on 31/07/19 ("Promotional Period").
6. To be eligible to participate and receive entries in accordance with 7 below, eligible entrants must, at any time during the Promotional Period, register their details by completing a registration form in full and returning it to any Participating Store in NSW. For clarity, registration forms will be available in-store and can be completed at any time during the Promotional Period regardless of when or if they make a Qualifying Purchase (as defined below), however if a registration form is not completed and returned, an entrant will not be entitled to receive any entries accrued in accordance with Clause 7 below. By completing a registration form, eligible entrants are giving Ison&Co permission to share their sales data with the Promoter for the purposes of this promotion.
7. To enter, individuals must complete the following steps during the Promotional Period:
 - a) Spend a minimum of \$500 (inclusive of GST) on any James Hardie™ product/s on their account ("Qualifying Purchase") at a Participating Store during the Promotional Period. Entrants will receive one (1) official entry form for each \$500 (inclusive of GST) spent on their account at a Participating Store. For example, if an eligible entrant spends \$900 (inclusive of GST) on James Hardie™ products on their account at the Participating Store during the Promotional Period, the eligible entrant will be awarded one (1) entry into the draw. If an eligible entrant spends \$1,900 (inclusive of GST) on James Hardie™ products at the Participating Store during the Promotional Period, the eligible entrant will be awarded three (3) entries into the draw and so on. For clarity, the required spend amount does not have to be in a single transaction/order and can be made up of multiple transactions/orders at multiple Participating Stores over the Promotional Period.
 - b) In all instances, prizes will be awarded to the registered owner of the trade account who may, in his/her absolute discretion, allocate the prize to any employee (aged 18 years or over) of the business associated with the trade account (the "Prize Recipient"). The Prize Recipient agrees to abide by these Terms and Conditions as a condition of accepting the prize.
 - c) Incomplete orders/transactions will be deemed invalid.
8. Entrants must retain a copy of their purchase receipt(s) as proof of purchase. Failure to produce the proof of purchase when requested may, in the absolute discretion of the Promoter, result in invalidation of ALL of an entrant's entries and forfeiture of any right to the prize. Purchase receipt(s) must clearly specify the store of purchase and that the purchase was made during the promotional period but prior to entry.
9. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
10. If, during the Promotional Period and until the prize is awarded, any James Hardie™ products contributing towards a minimum spend in a Qualifying Purchase are returned for refund or credit, or exchanged for a product or products that are not eligible for entry into this promotion (i.e. non James Hardie™ products), and/or which reduce the value of relevant Qualifying Purchase to below the minimum \$500 requirement, the Promoter reserves the right in its absolute discretion to invalidate any entries awarded in respect of that Qualifying Purchase (or reduce the number of entries awarded accordingly).
11. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
12. There will be one initial draw ("Initial Draw") and one major draw ("Major Draw"). All valid entries received during the Promotional Period will be entered into the Initial Draw. All valid entries drawn in the Initial Draw will then be entered into the Major Draw.
13. The Initial Draw will take place at Anisimoff Legal, Suite 5, Erina Plaza, 210 Central Coast Highway, Erina NSW 2250 on 09/08/2019 at 10am. The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries and record them in order in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn. The winners of the Initial Draw will be notified via telephone and email within two (2) business days of the Initial Draw.
14. The first three (3) valid entries drawn in the Initial Draw will each win each entrant ("Participant") an entry into the Major Draw.
15. The Major Draw will take place at Ison & Co South Nowra, 154-156 Princes Highway, South Nowra NSW 2541 on 16/08/2019 at 3:00pm AEST in the presence of a scrutineer. If a Participant cannot attend the Major Draw, the Participant may appoint a proxy over 18 years of age to attend the Major Draw on his/her behalf provided the Participant gives the Promoter written, signed notice to that effect before the start of the Major Draw.
